Atlantic Scaffolding was recently contracted by CB&I to provide a jig stand at a major Gulf Coast refinery. The scaffolding was being used on an FCCU project, supporting the structure, as well as allowing for the human access needed to install the cyclones.

The project was in progress as Hurricane Rita approached, and

although the scaffolding is designed for a certain level of winds, category 4 or 5 winds are frightening and unpredictable, so Atlantic secured the jig stand to an adjacent structure.

The refinery was hit by Hurricane Rita, and after the dust had cleared, Atlantic's scaffolding had withstood the 150-mile-per-hour winds.

Atlantic's technology separates it from the rest of the pack. Its unique EXCEL scaffolding system — an alternative jig stand solution — provides user-friendly components, making every scaffolding job safer and more efficient. The EXCEL system is durable, strong and lightweight. It features "no tool, automatic positive locking trigger connector" and exceeds all OSHA and Cal-OSHA requirements.

The company's FIMSS (fully integrated modular shoring system), which is part of the EXCEL system, can be used in an array of different applications.

Atlantic's alternative jig stand solution results in fraction of the costs of previous methods, and it is also portable and reusable. The scaffolding is dual functioning — it is engineered to handle four times the maximum load, and it allows for craft access.
